WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Jeannette Livingston, SCDDO Deputy Director, welcomed everyone.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Kristen made a motion to approve the minutes and Chelsea seconded the motion. The minutes from June 24, 2022 Community Council Executive Committee meeting and July 22, 2022 Community Council Meeting minutes were approved.

QAC OUTCOMES

Support Plan Data

- Individuals reviewed – 91
- Receiving day services only – 64
- Receiving residential services and supports – 49
- Receiving personal care services via an agency – 5
- Receiving personal care services self-directed - 29

Out of 91 Services reviewed, there were 106 deficiencies out of a possible 1,802

Notable areas:

- Choice section had no deficiencies
- Goal development within the TCM services showed up at least 10 times. Goal development opportunities for TCM's can be done through the TCM Training Certification program could be used as a resource.

Experiments:

- A questions was asked about whether DSP's should be aware of nutritional support needs or psychotropic medication if they are not preparing meals or administering the meds. Yes because they are responsible for making sure they aren't having adverse reactions and even thought they might not be preparing meals there is a lot of food in many activities they participate in. CDDO did commit to being as consistent as can be in the evaluation process.

Kristen asked about goals – How do we help people live their preferred lifestyles? State is wanting Case Managers to get away from support need based goals and focus on wants, wishes and desires.

Experiment with how to engage with care givers for self-directed care has been finalized and incorporated into our quality assurance committee process.

UPDATE ON SCDDO DIRECTOR'S POSITION

Anytime we have a leadership role vacancy, the county wants us to make sure the position needs to be filled. Are there other opportunities available? Tim has asked that we explore the option of CDDO and Department of Aging being merged. A workgroup has been established that includes senior management of CDDO and Department of Aging and 1 employee from CDDO and 1 employee from

Department of Aging. The workgroup has been asked to make recommendations about if we would merge and if so, what it would look like. Work needs to be completed by mid-October.

Has anyone else merged? One CDDO has but not much information is known. They are a very small CDDO. Many years ago the state issued a RFP to merge CDDO's under Aging and Disability and it cause a lot of concern for our organization. We plan to survey other CDDO, state agencies, and IDD community.
