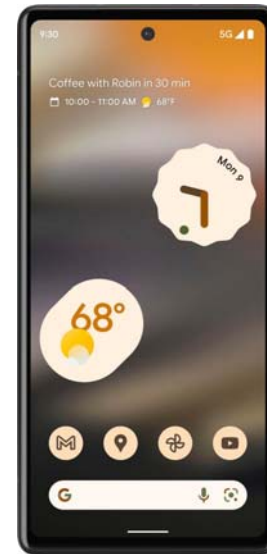

Monthly Med Dispensers

Xihome \$15

- ▶ Smaller for easy dosing
- ▶ Has AM and PM
- ▶ Fill once a month
- ▶ Can take on the go

The Med Center \$42

- ▶ Bigger for more complicated dosing
- ▶ Has 4 slots (Morning, Noon, Evening and Night).
- ▶ Fill once a month
- ▶ Color coded pill boxes shows when the daily dose is complete



LiveFine Automatic Pill Dispenser

\$70

- ▶ Can program up to 1X - 6X daily
- ▶ 28 days max
- ▶ 18 pills can fit in each slot
- ▶ Prevents forgetting with alerts, beeping and flashing lights
- ▶ Easy to use and take on the go
- ▶ Cover locks in place with a key
- ▶ Takes 4 AA batteries

C Pen ExamReader

- ▶ The C Pen ExamReader helps with reading difficulties like dyslexia.
- ▶ It is portable and pocket-sized!
- ▶ Reads aloud with a digital voice in 3 different languages. English, Spanish or French!
- ▶ Instantly displays a definition when you highlight a word.
- ▶ The pen can also scan and store text to a computer.

- ▶ Scan to text, not only on paper but also your cellphone and any screen.
- ▶ Two way speech translation, recognize up to 114 different languages.
- ▶ Speech to text, this helps you read while others speak in real-time.
