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What is a CDDO?

- CDDO's:
 - Serve as a single point of application & referral for services for persons with IDD
 - Determine if a person is eligible for IDD services
 - Provide information on and explain available services & service providers
 - Organize a Council of Community Members



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Young Children & Eligibility

- Different process for children under 6 years of age:
 - At least 3 types of delays
 - List of assessments used to identify delays
 - Describe services child is receiving *or is needing*
 - Cannot be solely mental health related
 - Delays *likely* to continue indefinitely



Eligible for What?

- IDD Medicaid Waiver funding limited to 5 & up
 - Waitlist
- IDD Targeted Case Management
- Family Support or Incidental Consumer Supports
- Parson's Outreach Team
