## **Unfinished Business**

The equipment currently meets the requirements of A17.7 (performance based code); however, it does not comply with the current code (A17.1 2004/5) as adopted by the City of Wichita, Kansas.

Mr. Evans provided a detailed handout of the new equipment to the Board. After a question and answer period and some discussion of the installation process and equipment, Board Member Naylor made a motion to approve the variance for the machine roomless hydraulic elevator. Board Member Nelson seconded the motion. The majority of the Board opposed the acceptance of the variance pending further discussion.

Board Member Hawkins made a motion to continue the discussion about the machine roomless hydraulic elevator variance request at the next regular monthly meeting. Board Member Kilian seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Board Member Naylor made a motion to set a meeting for two weeks from the date to begin the review of the 2014 NEC. Board Member Kilian seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

With no other business to conduct, Board Member Nelson made a motion to adjourn. Board Member Naylor seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
