Unfinished Business

New Business

Mr. Kerschen explained to the Board that there are two elevator code for safety code for elevators and escalators. MABCD has, in its local ordinance, the adoption of ASME A17.1 and that code is for new installations of elevators and escalators.

The second code is ASME A17.3. This code is for existing elevators and escalators. This code has been available for several years but MABCD has never adopted it. MABCD would like the Board to review the A17.3 code for possible adoption, understanding that a code that would require changes and upgrades to existing elevators could be controversial.

Board member Naylor made a motion that a subcommittee with at least one Board member on it, be created to get the building owners and public involvement in the review of the A17.3 code and this subcommittee is to report back its findings to this Board. Board member Hawkins seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Kerschen gave the Board members a copy of the summary of code changes of the A17.1 – 2010 to the A17.1 – 2013 for the Board members to look over and the Board will start the review at the March regular meeting.

With no other business to conduct, Board Member Nelson made a motion to adjourn. Board Member Naylor seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
