Unfinished Business

The Board continued the review of the ASME A17.1-2013 code. Board member Nelson suggested to have Mr. Kerschen send the packet of changes to each licensed elevator contractor and allow them time to look over the changes and submit concerns for the Board to review. Board member Nelson made a motion to postpone the review of the ASME A17.1-2013 code for 90 days. Board member Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

New Business

Part A, wiring methods for garages and accessory buildings associated with multi-family. The Board discussed different wiring methods depending on the type and use of the structure and if the structure was open to the framing members or had wall covering installed. The Board discussed that changing the Unified Building and Trade Code (UBTC) would, most likely, just confuse the situation. Board member Naylor made a motion to leave the UBTC article as written. Board member Haskins seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Part B, license number of business cards, invoices and proposals. The Board discussed if it was necessary to have license numbers on business cards. Attorney Waggoner explained to the Board, that from a legal point of view, having the requirement for license numbers on business cards helped the attorneys in showing if there was an attempt to misrepresent themselves to the customer. After continued discussion Board member Ragland made a motion to leave the UBTC article as written. Board member Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

With no other business to conduct, Board Member Naylor made a motion to adjourn. Board Member Nelson seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
