Unfinished Business

The Board Members considered the CET and CAT programs as an approved method for elevator mechanics to achieve their training and certification. The Board asked that Mr. Nordick to contact several organizations to gather more information to bring back to the Board at a later date.

The Board Members considered requiring CEU's for elevator mechanics for the upcoming 2019 renewal cycle. The Board Asked Mr. Nordick to contact several organizations to inquire about the availability of CEU classes and to determine what would be required for legislative change for the elevator code. This will be brought back to the Board at a later date.

New Business

The Board discussed allowing commercially permitted, multi-family dwelling, detached garages, to be wired using NM-B (Romex). The code does not allow separate structures that are considered commercial to be wired with this type of wiring system. Vote required at next regular meeting.

The Board discussed the requirement for homeowner's exams to be given in English only. The Board was against allowing the exam to be designed in any other language than English, as other exams to certify electricians, are only given in English. Vote required at next regular meeting.

The Board discussed accepting Johnson County CEU's for electricians in Sedgwick County. This discussion will be moved to the Kansas Electrical Continuing Education Review Committee to consider, and the committee chairperson will report back to the Board.

With no other business to conduct. Board Member Belknap made a motion to adjourn, Board Member Schneider seconded the motion, and the motion was approved (7 - 0).
