Board Member Naylor nominated Board Member Kilian to serve as the Chairperson, Board Member Hawkins seconded the motion, and the nomination of Board Member Kilian as Chairperson for a second term was approved

Board Member Kilian nominated Board Member Lenz to serve as the Vice Chairperson, Board Member Hawkins seconded the motion, and the nomination of Board Member Lenz as Vice Chairperson for a second term was approved (7-0)

Mr. Nordick presented copies of the changes to the 2017 ASME A18.1 Safety Standard for platform lifts and stairway chairlifts to the Board Members for their review and discussion at the next regular meeting.

Mr. Nordick presented an off agenda item regarding an existing amendment from our UBTC Article 4 Sec. 3 – 4.3.030 – Mobile Home and Manufactured Homes. This amendment requires all Mobile and Manufactured Homes to be supplied with copper conductors. During our discussion Mr. Nordick presented his position and desire to eliminate this requirement, allowing the amendment to be repealed and allowing these homes to be supplied by a service that meets the 2017 NEC as adopted. This would allow the use of Aluminum conductors to serve the homes which will reduce costs while providing the same level of safety.

With no other business to conduct. Vice Chairman Naylor made a motion to adjourn, Board Member Schneider seconded the motion, and the motion was approved (7 - 0).
