Mr. Nordick provided the Board Members with information regarding group homes specific to their occupancy classification and whether to consider them a dwelling regarding wiring types and circuit protection. It was determined by the Board of Electrical Appeals that AFCI protection will be required for the sleeping areas of group homes, nursing homes and limited care facilities.

Mr. Nordick provided the Board Members with a request by ESA (Electronic Security Association) to approve their curriculum as an alternative equivalent to the NICET II credentialing requirement for fire alarm technicians. The Board requested that Mr. Nordick reach out to the City of Wichita Alarm Administrator and the Wichita Fire Department for the input as well as researching NFPA 72 (National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code) for clarification on requirements for agencies to be approved for fire alarm technician credentialing.

With no other business to conduct. Board Member Lenz made a motion to adjourn, Vice Chairman Hawkins seconded the motion, and the motion carried (6 - 0).
