#### **New Business**

Mr. Nordick presented to the Board, a variance request presented to Assistant Director Capello. This variance request was to allow NM (residential) type wiring systems at a specific project located at 8629 & 8631 W 29<sup>th</sup> St N.

Mr. Nordick provided the Board with a copy of the approved variance letter and a response email from the Chief Electrical Inspector to the variance committee expressing the initial concerns of allowing this type of wiring in the proposed occupancy. Mr. Nordick presented an argument as to why this could be allowed per the International Building Code (IBC), and the direct conflict that this allowance has with the Sec. 4.2.180 of the adopted UBTC.

Mr. Nordick presented to the Board a solution for the inconsistency with the current amendment and the International Building Code (IBC), which would include re-writing the local amendment to allow this type of wiring in R3 and R4 occupancies as defined in the International Building Code (IBC).

The Board Members requested that Mr. Capello come before the Board at the next regularly scheduled meeting to speak regarding his decision, and to ask questions regarding input of the Board of Electrical Appeals.

With no other business to conduct. Board Member Lenz made a motion to adjourn, Board Member Belknap seconded the motion, and the motion carried (7 - 0).
