### **Unfinished Business**

Mr. Nordick presented to the Board Members, a copy of the adopted plumbing code article regarding electrical bonding requirements for the installation of CSST gas piping, and discussion began about how to proceed with enforcement of this newly adopted code. The Board Members asked that Mr. Nordick present to them a proposed enforcement date, a guideline of how to enforce the code, and a copy of the proposed letter needed to send to all Electrical and Plumbing contractors.

With no other business to conduct, Board Member Belnap made a motion to adjourn. Board Member Hawkins seconded the motion. The motion was approved. (6 – 0)
