MABCD DIRECTIVE #15-E11 (ELECTRICAL DIRECTIVE)

ISSUE: Permanent Meter Release for Mobile/Manufactured Homes

EFFECTIVE DATE: Immediately

Electrical service inspections (and subsequent release to the utility company for permanent electrical connection) must be performed by the Electrical section of the Metropolitan Area Building & Construction Department whenever the following occur.

- A mobile/manufactured home installed on new lots where electrical service has never been established.
- Any time a mobile/manufactured home has been removed from a lot and another home moved on the same lot.

E11.1 A Metropolitan Area Building & Construction Department licensed Electrical Contractor or Kansas licensed Mobile/Manufactured Home Installer must install the necessary electrical wiring, obtain the required electrical permit and request inspection.

E11.2 Before the electrical service will be released to the utility company for permanent connection, a Metropolitan Area Building & Construction Department inspector must inspect and confirm that the building in question is secured properly and meets the applicable requirements pertaining to blocking and tie-down.

E11.3 All wiring rated 200 ampere or less must be copper.
